MAKE YOUR OWN HALLOWEEN BUNTING



STEP 1 Colour or decorate the images provided on the template and carefully cut them out.

STEP 3 Use your Sellotape to attach your images to a long piece of string or rope, to make your bunting.



STEP 2 Using your Pritt Stick, decorate your Halloween images with recycled materials, like foil or sweet wrappers to make your bunting reflective!

STEP 4 Hang up your Halloween bunting and enjoy!

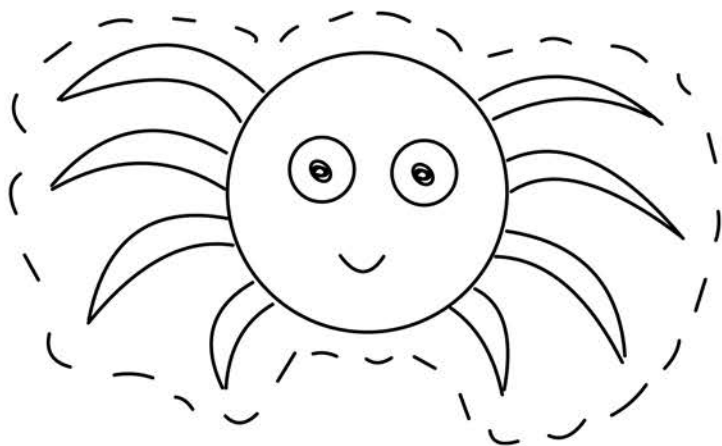
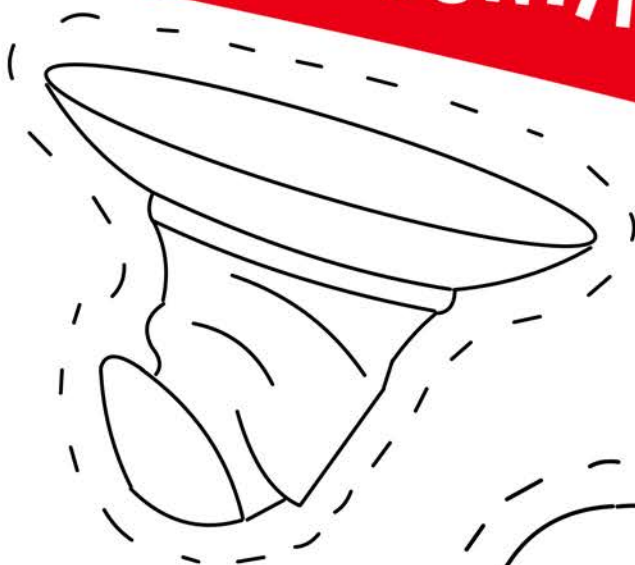

MAKE YOUR OWN BONFIRE NIGHT SCENE



STEP 1

Paint the inside and outside of an empty shoe box black. This will be your night sky.



STEP 2

Colour or decorate the rockets and stars provided on the template and carefully cut them out.



STEP 3

Decorate the tails of the rockets with recycled paper.



STEP 4

Using your Pritt Stick, glue your rockets and stars inside your box to make your bonfire night scene!

MAKE YOUR OWN BONFIRE NIGHT SCENE





MAKE YOUR OWN REMEMBRANCE DAY POPPY WREATH

STEP 1

Paint the inside part of the cupcake liners with red paint. Make sure you let the paint dry!



STEP 2

Using your scissors, carefully cut out a circle in the center of a paper plate.



STEP 3

Colour or decorate the shapes provided on the template and carefully cut them out.



STEP 4

Using your Pritt Stick, glue the little circles inside the cupcake liners.



STEP 5

Glue the cupcake liners and leaves around the paper plate circle using your Pritt Stick. Your poppy wreath is now ready! Hang it up to mark the day.

- Red paint
- Paper plate

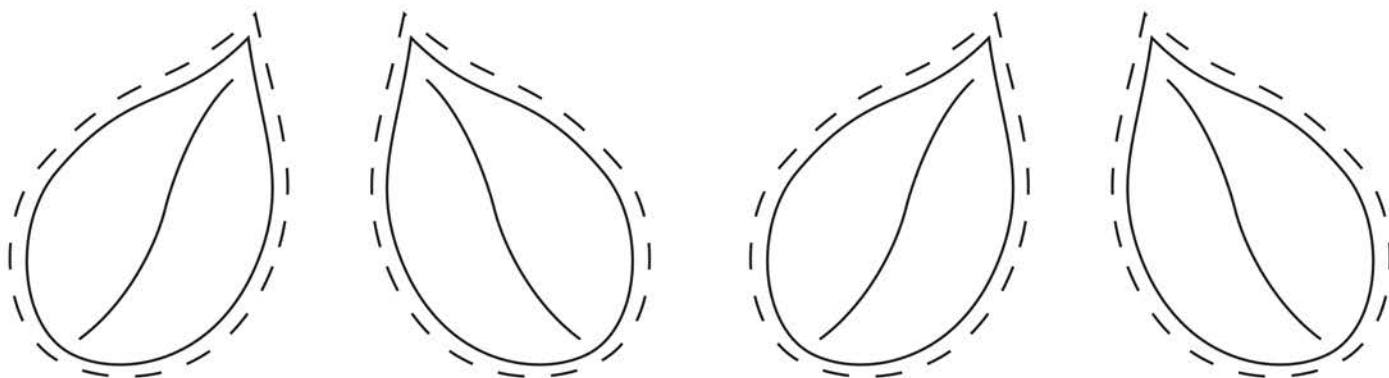
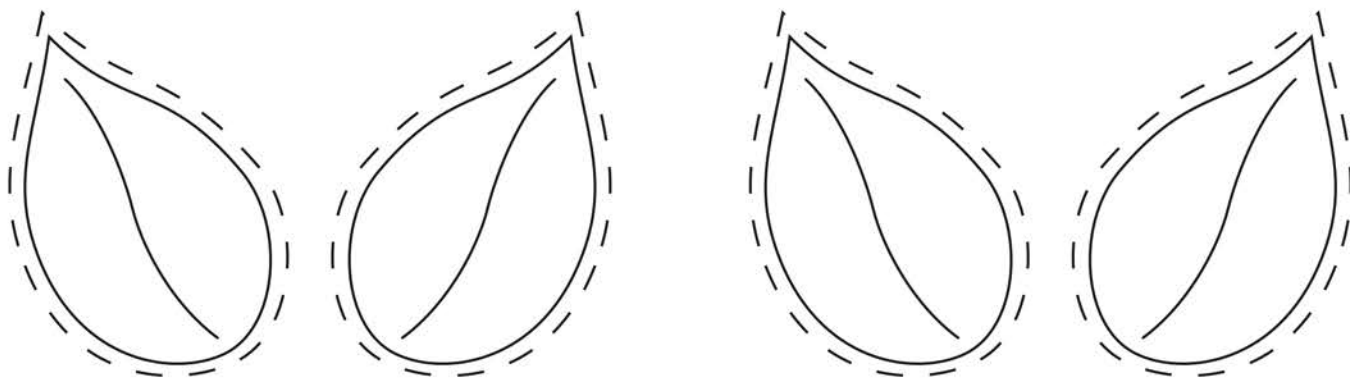
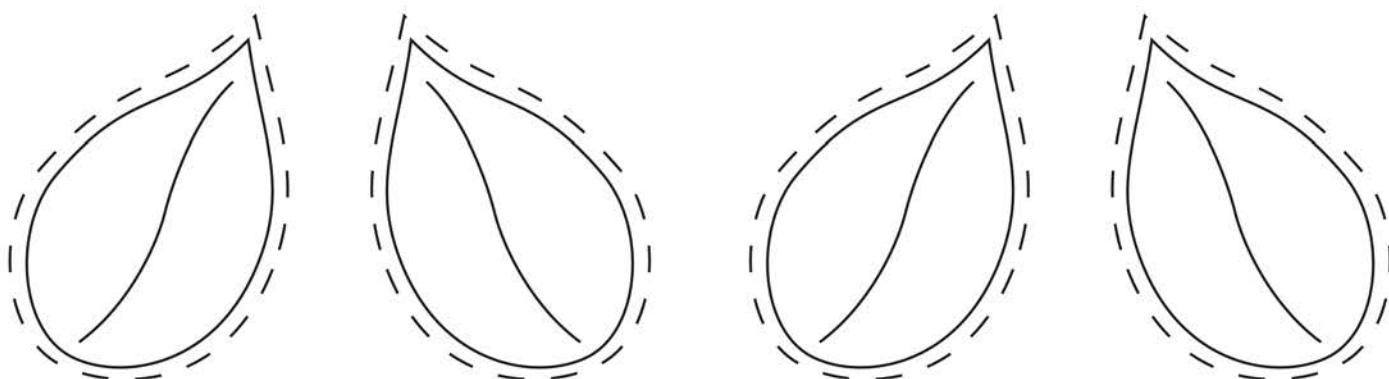
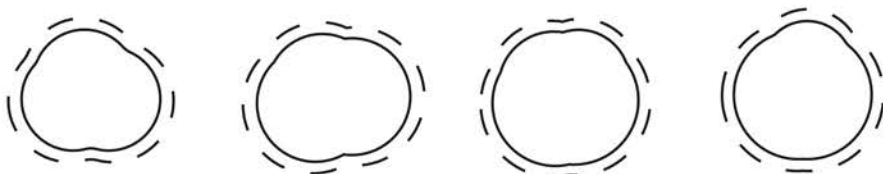
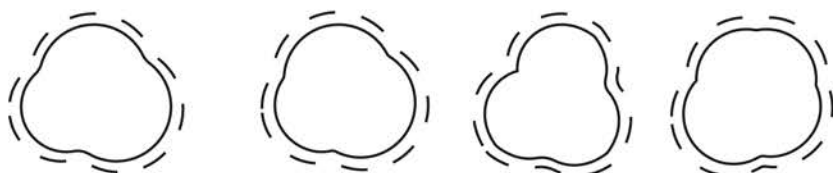
Use real leaves to bring your poppy wreath to life this Remembrance Day.

MAKE YOUR OWN DIWALI PAPER PLATE RANGOLI

STEP 1

Colour or decorate the shapes provided on the template using coloured pens or pencils and then carefully cut them out with your scissors.



STEP 2

Using a Pritt Stick, glue the shapes to a paper plate from the center to the edges.



STEP 3

Using paint, or coloured pens or pencils, decorate the plate. When using paint, make sure you leave enough time to let the paint dry.

STEP 4

You have your Rangoli ready and can now celebrate the Festival of Lights!

- Paper plate
- Coloured pens/pencils
- Paint
- Scissors

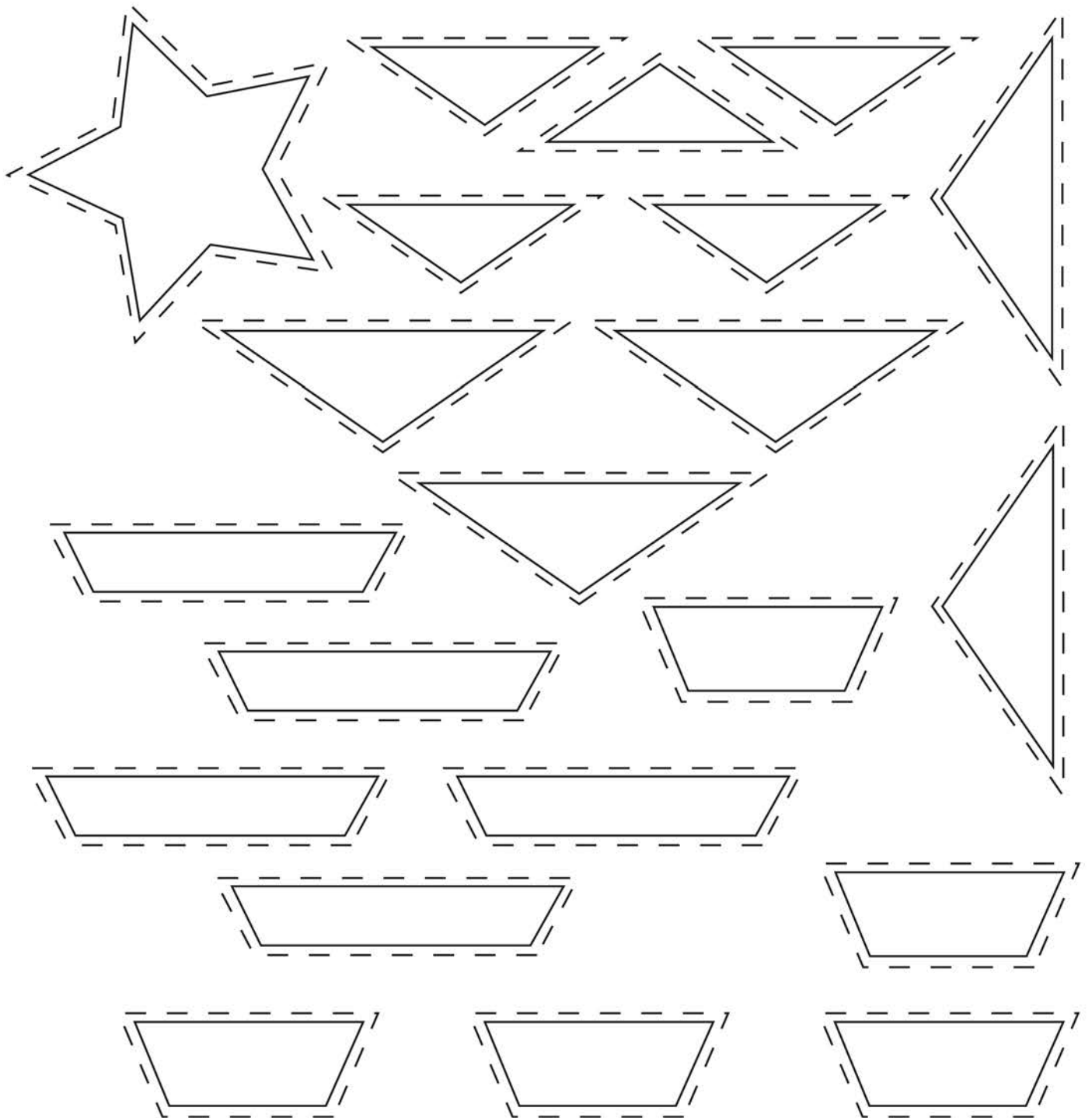

MAKE YOUR OWN DIWALI PAPER PLATE RANGOLI





MAKE YOUR OWN HANNUKAH PAPER PLATE MENORAH

STEP 1

Colour and carefully cut out the candles and flames from the template.



STEP 2

Paint a paper plate with yellow or gold paint. When it's dry, fold in half and use your Pritt Stick to hold it in place.



STEP 3

Assemble eight candles and flames. Then, using your Pritt Stick, glue them in place along the top of your menorah.



STEP 4

Place the longer candle and flame in the centre, making the central shamash candle that is used to light all the others.

STEP 5

Finally, fasten a length of ribbon to each side of the menorah so that you can hang it up!

You will need

- Pritt Stick
- Paper plate
- Coloured pens/pencils
- Yellow/gold paint
- Scissors

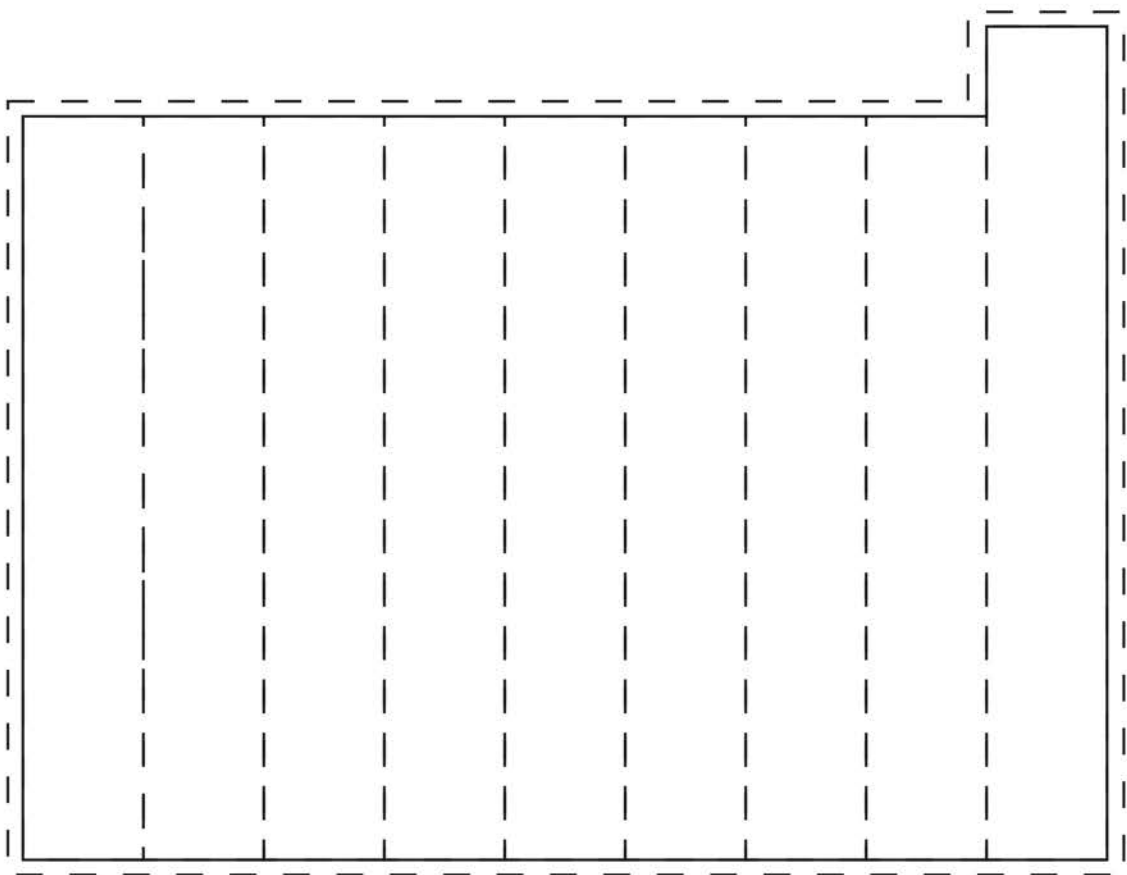
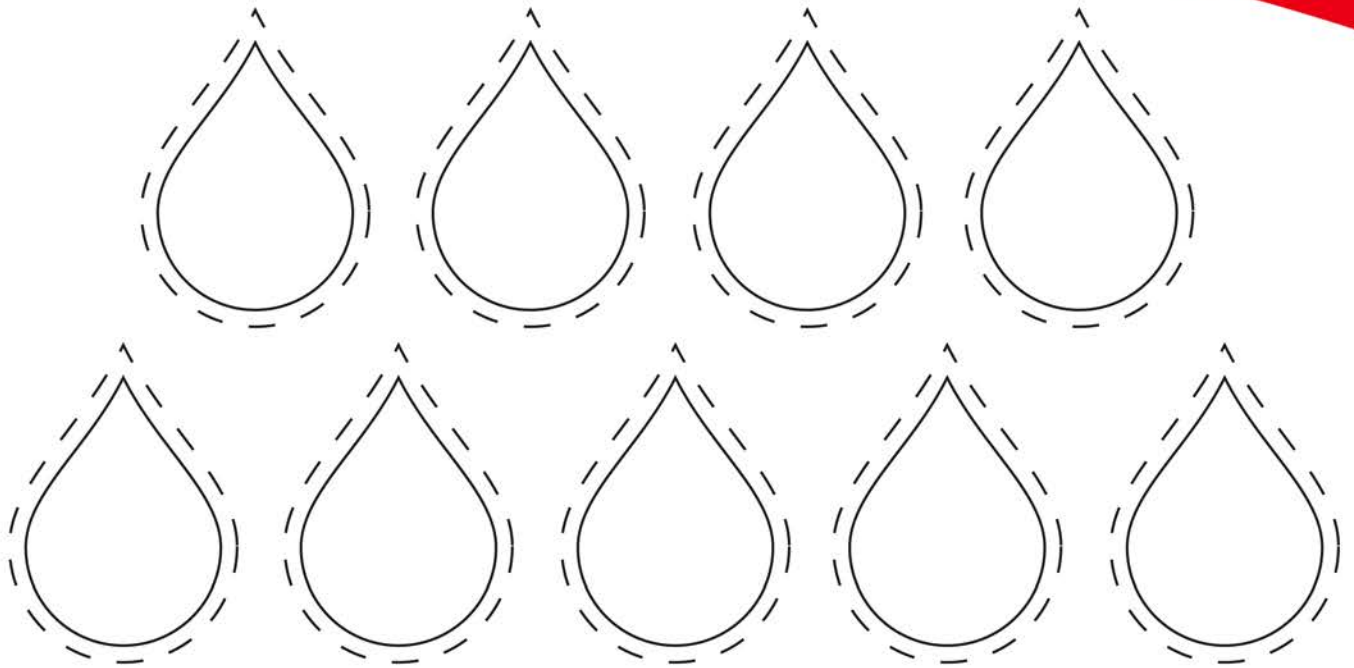


Why not?

MAKE YOUR OWN ADVENT CALENDAR

STEP 1 Colour or decorate Santa's face and hat on the template provided and carefully cut them out.



STEP 2 Then, using your Pritt Stick, glue your hat to the top of Santa's head.

STEP 3 Glue a large cotton ball to the tip of the hat. You could even add more cotton balls around the trim to add texture!

STEP 4 Using your scissors, carefully cut a long beard shape from white paper or card, or use the template provided, and glue to Santa's face.

STEP 5 Write the dates of the month leading up to Christmas on the beard. Remember, there are 25 days leading up to the big day!

STEP 6 Finally, using ribbon or string, hang up your calendar and set a bowl of cotton balls and a Pritt Stick nearby to tick off each day on the countdown to Christmas!

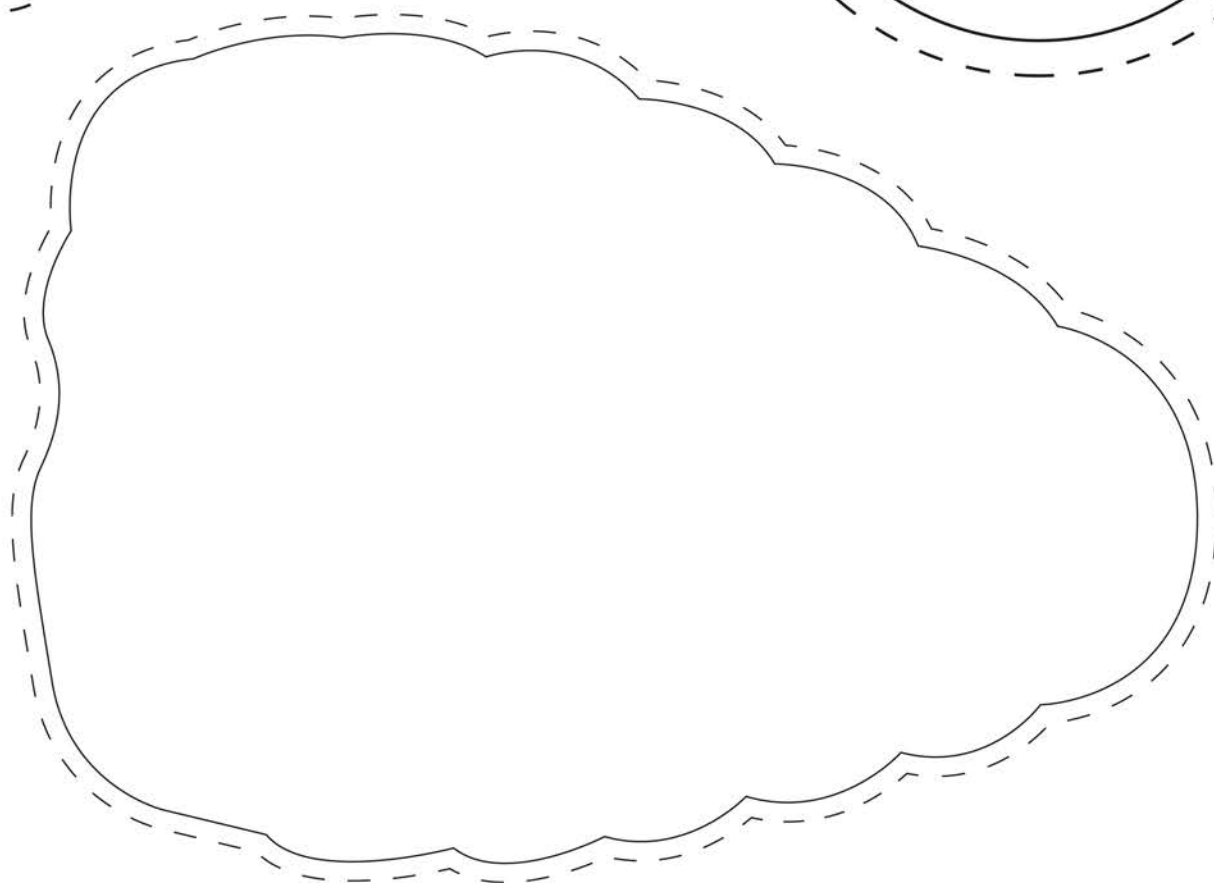
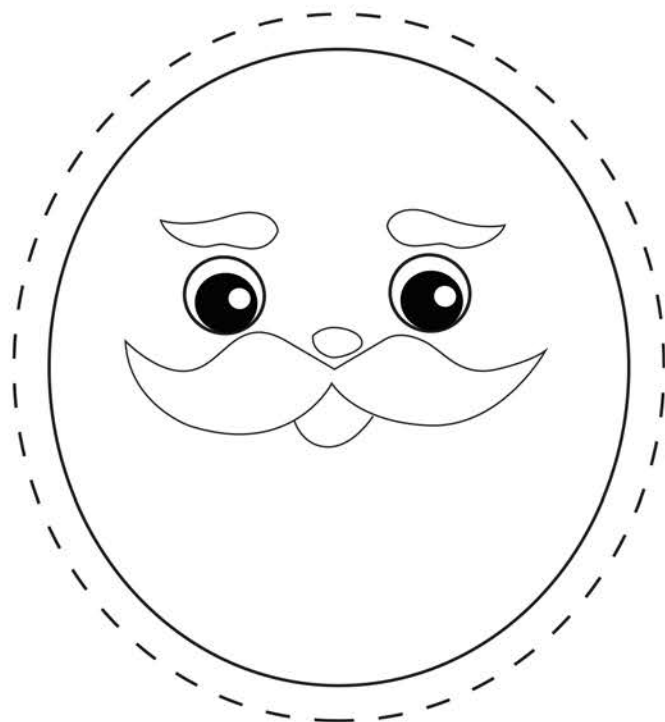
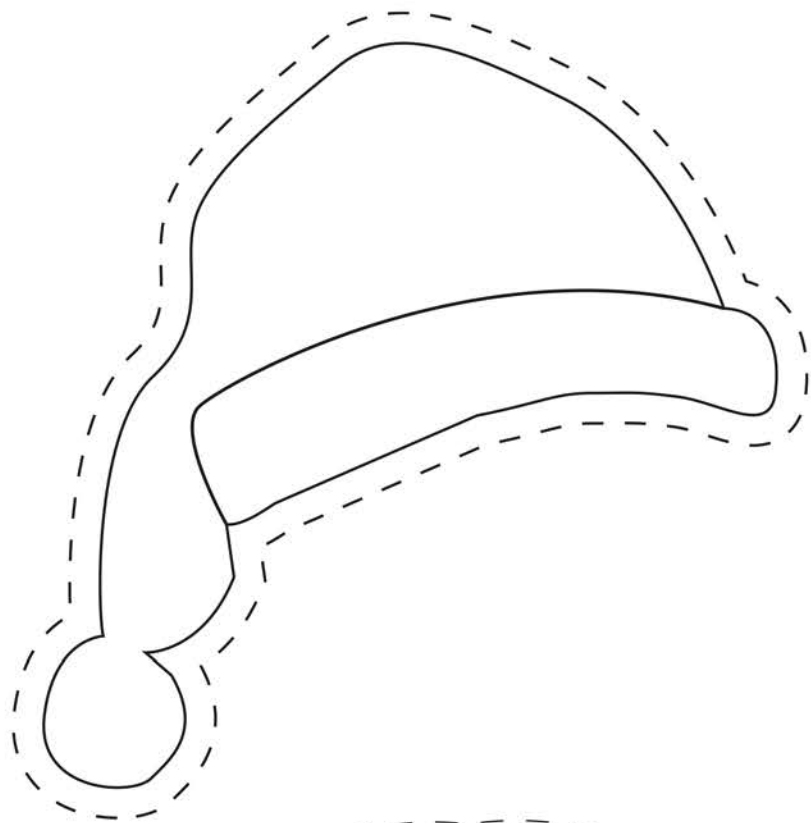
